

# Erasmus for Young Entrepreneurs Global

**EYE Global** ( <http://eyeglobal.eu> ) is a pilot project financed by the European Commission to facilitate the exchange of European new entrepreneurs and experienced host entrepreneurs in the **USA, Singapore and Israel** with the help of the local contact points, active in the field of business support and entrepreneurship.

## Who can participate?

- *Experienced entrepreneurs* who own and manage a Small or Medium-Sized Enterprise based in the USA (states of New York and Pennsylvania), Singapore or **Israel**.
- *European New entrepreneurs*, firmly planning to set up their own business or have less than 3 years of entrepreneurial experience.

The **host entrepreneur** (HE) can benefit from *fresh ideas* from a motivated new entrepreneur who can support the experienced entrepreneur in *being more successful in expanding his/her business in the EU market*. **New entrepreneurs** (NE), on the other hand, benefit from an experience in a small or medium-sized enterprise in a country outside Europe. This will ease the successful start of their business or strengthen their new enterprise.

The exchange between the two entrepreneurs, which can last between 1-3 months, is a **win-win collaboration** whereby both of entrepreneurs can also discover new markets or business partners, as well as different ways of doing business.

As a host entrepreneur you can participate in the programme if:

- Your company is registered in Israel and you are residing in that country;
- You are the owner-manager of a small or medium enterprise OR a person directly involved in entrepreneurship at SME board level (not employee);
- You have more than 3 years of cumulative experience as an entrepreneur (owner-manager of own company, not employee);
- You are willing to share your knowledge and experience with a new entrepreneur and act as a mentor.
